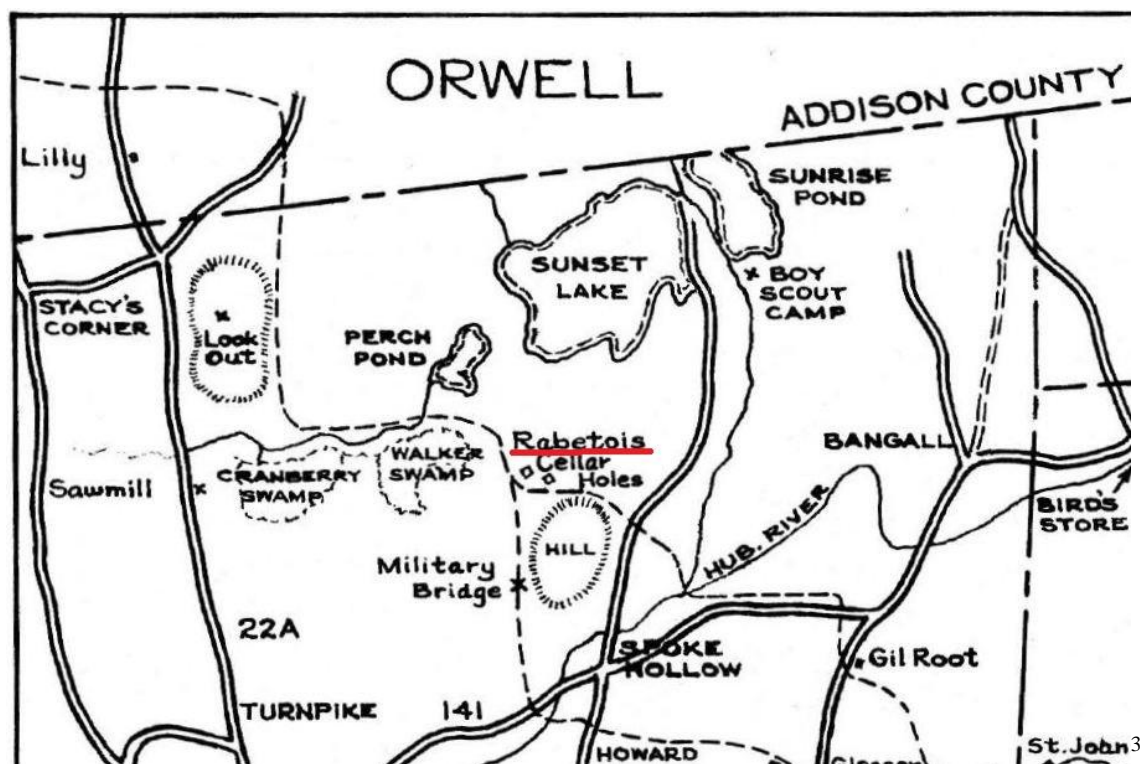


First Generation

X. **Anthony Rabadaux** was born in East Canada about 1805. By the late 1830s, he married **Rosetta/Sophia/Josephine** _____, who was born in Canada about 1793-5. They immigrated to the United States in the late 1840s. Where they were living in 1850 has not been determined.

In 1860, Anthony and his family were living in Orwell, Addison County, Vermont where he was a charcoal worker.¹ By 1870, they had relocated to Benson, Rutland County, Vermont where he worked as a farm laborer. At that time he had no real or personal assets. He and his wife could neither read or write.²

Anthony died on 17 Apr 1879⁴ and is buried in the Old Cemetery in Benson.⁵

In 1880, Josephine was living within the household of her son, Venis, in Benson.⁶

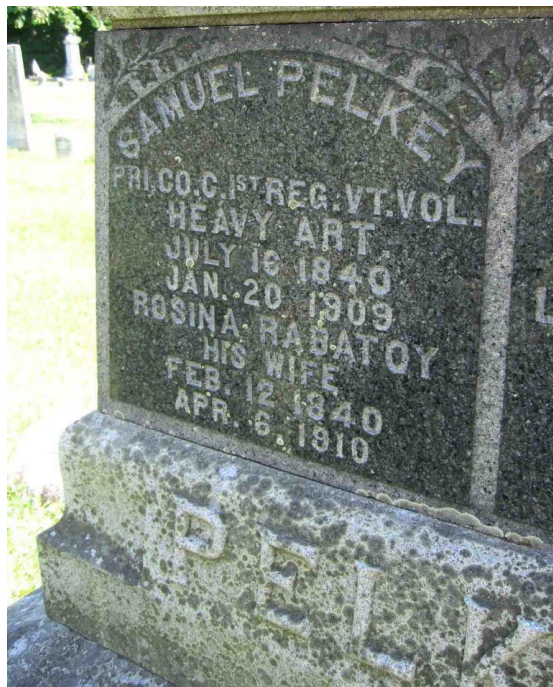
X. **Rosina Rabatoy**, daughter of Anthony Rabadaux and Josephine _____, was born on 12 Feb 1840 in Canada. She married on 9 Jul 1858 **Samuel Pelkey**. Rev. E. Smith, Minister of the Gospel officiated at the wedding in Benson, Rutland County, Vermont.⁷ In 1860, they resided in Orwell, Addison County, Vermont where Samuel worked as a coal laborer⁸ and Benson, where he was a farm laborer.⁹

During the Civil War, Samuel served as a private with Company C, First Regiment of Vermont Volunteers.

By 1870, they had relocated to Plymouth, Windsor County, Vermont where Samuel worked as a teamster.¹⁰ In 1880, they lived in Mount Holly, Rutland County, Vermont where Samuel was now a farmer.¹¹

By 1900, they had relocated to Wallingford, Rutland County, Vermont where Samuel worked as a lumberman. Living with them that year was their son, Peter and his wife, Lulu. At that time Peter rented a farm.¹²

Samuel died on 20 Jan 1909 in Wallingford.¹³ Rosina died on 6 Apr 1910 in Wallingford.¹⁴ Both are buried in the Laurel Glen Cemetery, Cuttingsville, Vermont.

X. **Anthony Rabator**, son of Anthony Rabadaux and Josephine _____ was born on 30 Oct 1841 in Canada;¹⁶ He was living at home with his parents in Orwell, Addison County, Vermont in 1860. He married about 1863 **Mary Philinda Sears** who was born in 1844 in Whitehall, New York, the daughter of Alexander Sears.

In 1870, they were living in Benson, Rutland County, Vermont where Anthony worked as a teamster and had personal assets of \$150.¹⁷ They were still in Benson in 1880 where Anthony now worked as a day laborer.¹⁸ They continued the same in 1900.¹⁹

Philinda died on 7 Feb 1901 in Benson.²⁰ In 1910, Anthony was living alone on his farm in Benson and worked at odd jobs.²¹

Anthony died on 5 Dec 1913 in Orwell, Addison County, Vermont.²² Children, all born in Vermont:

X. **Joseph Rabiteaux/ Rabitoux**, son of son of Anthony Rabadaux and Josephine _____ was born about 1843 in Canada. In 1860, he was living at home with his parents in Benson, Rutland County, Vermont.²⁸ On 30 Jul 1862 he enlisted at Benson to serve in the Civil War. He mustered in on 1 Sep 1862 as a private in Company C, 11th Vermont Infantry, which later became the 1st Regiment of Vermont Heavy Artillery. Joseph was wounded at Winchester, Virginia on 19 Sep 1864. The following month he was killed in action on 19 Oct 1864 at Cedar Creek. He is buried in the Winchester National Cemetery, Virginia, plot #4169.²⁹

X. **Venis Rabtoy**, son of Anthony Rabadaux and Josephine _____, was born in Dec 1845 in Canada. He was living at home with his parents in 1860.

As “Venice Rabiteaux,” at the age of 18 he enlisted at Benson on 23 Dec 1863 to serve in the Civil War. He mustered in on 26 Dec 1863 as a private in Company B, 8th Vermont Volunteer Infantry. He transferred to the Veteran Reserve Corps on 15 Jun 1864 and mustered out was on 15 Jul 1865.³¹

Venis married around 1875 **Delia Twine** who was born in Canada on 27 Oct 1855.

In 1880, they were living in Benson, Rutland County, Vermont where Venis worked as a laborer. Living within their household that year was Venis’ 90 year old widowed mother, Josephine.³² In 1890, Venis was living in Mt. Holly, Rutland County, Vermont.³³

By 1900, Venis and his family were living in Wallingford, Rutland County, Vermont where Venice was a day laborer and lived in a rented house.³⁴

Venice died in Wallingford on 7 Feb 1922.³⁵ Delia died on 5 Feb 1937 in Vermont.³⁶ Both are buried in Maple Grove Cemetery in Wallingford. Children:

X. **Jennie Rabator**, daughter of Anthony Rabadaux and Josephine _____, was born on 29 Mar 1847 probably in Canada. She married around 1867 **Theodore Denno**. In 1880, they were living in Mount Holly, Rutland County, Vermont where Theodore was employed as a chopper.³⁸

Jennie died on 19 Jun 1910 in Sudbury, Rutland County, Vermont³⁹ and is buried in Hill Cemetery, Sudbury.⁴⁰ Theodore was born on 25 Jun 1837. He served as a private in Company B of the 5th Regiment of Vermont Volunteer during the Civil War. He died on 14 Sep 1917 and is buried with his wife.
